Notice on Global Science Summer Programme 2020

Dear Students,

Registration for Global Science Summer Programme (GSSP) 2020 is now open.

In view of the Coronavirus situation, NUS will make a decision by mid-May 2020 on whether to proceed with the Global Science Summer Programme or cancel it.

Currently, Singapore has imposed travel restrictions for people travelling from China and people holding the People's Republic of China (PRC) passports. More details can be found here https://www.ica.gov.sg/news-and-publications/public-education/updates-on-border-control-measures.

Students affected by the current travel restrictions may still apply for the GSSP and if you are selected for the programme, a conditional offer will be made. Students will only be able to participate in the GSSP, if all the travel restrictions are lifted by mid-May 2020.

All students will only be required to make payment for the programme fee after mid-May 2020.

In view of the above, the \$100 registration fee will be refunded under the following two situations:

- If NUS cancels the Global Science Summer Programme 2020.
- If students are denied entry into Singapore due to travel restrictions brought about by the Coronavirus.

Request to refund the \$100 registration fee due to other reasons will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
